Thank you for requesting the comments of the New York State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). We have reviewed the submitted materials in accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966. These comments are those of the SHPO and relate only to Historic/Cultural resources.

The project was submitted to SHPO as a residential development consisting Phase 1, covering an area of 13.5 acres, and Phase 2, covering an area of 8.9 acres. We have reviewed the report entitled "Phase 1 Cultural Resource Survey, Lansing Development Project, Town of Lansing, Tompkins County, New York" (August 28, 2017). The archaeological survey covered the area corresponding to Phase 1. No archaeological survey of the area corresponding to Phase 2 has been conducted, and it is SHPO's opinion that an archaeological survey of the area of Phase 2 should be conducted. No archaeological resources were identified during the archaeological survey of the area of Phase 1. It is SHPO's opinion that the development of the approximately 14 acres corresponding with Phase 1 will have No Effect upon cultural resources in or eligible for inclusion in the National Registers of Historic Places.
