Planning Consultant Mike Long called the meeting to order at 7:08pm

Minutes:

- Paper Copies of the Minutes from the Last 2 Meetings were passed out to the group

Draft List of Maps:

- Discussion revolving around 11x17 Maps that will be attached to Comprehensive Plan as Appendices occurred
 - See Attached Map List
- There was a question as to the Zoning of the Cargill Shaft with regard to the Property Use Classification Map
- A question regarding the White areas along Salmon Creek with regard to the Agricultural Soils Map
- Several questions revolved around the Agricultural Soils Map (i.e.- Difference between State Importance and Importance)
- Inaccuracies were noted with regard to the Agricultural Properties Map. There are two places that are not listed as Agricultural Land that are.
- Inaccuracies were noted in the Protected Lands map
- It was requested that names and labels were added to the Protected Lands Map
- Inaccuracies were noted in the Economic Development map (Empire Zones near Drake Rd.)
- It was noted that many Historical and Cultural Elements appear to be missing on the Cultural Resources Map

- Mike Recommended bringing Michael Tomlin from Cornell University Historic Preservation Program to develop a Cultural and Historical Resource Inventory
- It has been requested that streams be added to the Watershed Map
- Discussion revolving around the type of Trail System Map to use, i.e. level of detail (Current, In Progress, Agreements) occurred.
- Questions Revolved around Residential and Agricultural Classification- Does a Residential Area include farm area that has not been given an agricultural exemption?
- It was requested a Topographical Map Be Added to the List of Maps
- Dan provided an enlarged Sewer district map of the Warren Road Sewer District with an Aerial View of the Area.
 - The Scale of His Map will be combined with the layout and information on the map Mike provided
- Discussion revolving around the Business/ Employee Numbers on the Economic Development Map Occurred
 - It was suggested to look at this data in Tabular Form as opposed to a map.
 - Joe will look at employment information from other sources
 - Types of Positions, Median Incomes by Positions, Density of Businesses, and Density of Employees
- A Map that Discusses Scenic Vistas and Protected Views needs to be established and added.
 - Ruth will recruit people to assist with establishing a list of vistas, and views
- Discussion occurred revolving around traffic counts in the area and how best to present it.
 - Mike is going to look into finding information on Historic Trends on Traffic Data
