*Dan F-* Lead discussion about how the best planning is making sure that people know they need to have their own emergency plan if power goes out, heat is interrupted, and communication and travel is disrupted. Neighbor to neighbor support is critical to a successful emergency plan.

*Karen B-* lead discussion about how creating a list of vulnerable residents is not useful or legal unless they voluntarily put themselves on a list. Medical support for various health needs can be addressed in a general population shelter, such as the Lansing Central Schools. The medical support would be available through Tompkins County.

*General-* All agreed that it was essential that we have Lansing Fire Department leadership present at future meetings.
